## WECU EDUCATION CENTER (5659 Barrett Road, Ferndale) FEATURES AND USE GUIDELINES

WECU offers free use of our Education Center at Ferndale to local non-profit organizations for meetings 8 a.m. until 10 p.m., 7 days per week. Reservations are booked on a first-ask, first-served basis. In order to serve as many groups as possible, we allow one use per group in any 30-day period.

## Location:

The Education Center at Ferndale is located at 5659 Barrett Road, Ferndale, in WECU's Ferndale branch.

## Features:

- Capacity: 114 persons maximum
- Clean, non-smoking, ADA-compliant facility
- Onsite lot parking
  - 35 spaces are available during business hours; please park at the back of the lot in order to leave the spaces closest to our building available to our members who are transacting business
  - o 60 spaces are available after business hours, including weekends
- Restrooms: 2 large, clean
- Tables: 15 rectangular
- Chairs: 100 meeting-style formed plastic
- Electronic screen and projector
  - (Users must provide own computer)
- Kitchenette with refrigerator, sink, microwave, coffee maker, hot water dispenser
- Coffee, tea, related condiments and cups provided by WECU

## Use Guidelines:

- No smoking is allowed inside the facility
- Animals (other than Service Animals) are not allowed inside the building
- Sales or collection of fees is prohibited
- No fundraising may occur on the premises
- Meetings are not open to the public and are not to be advertised as such
- It is the user's responsibility to pick up the key during WECU business hours; delivery of the key is not available; key may not be picked up in the drive-through
- User must store all furnishings, empty trash bins, clean kitchenette, vacuum and return key after use
- Facility is checked by WECU's Ferndale staff; any misuse will be recorded and may prohibit further use by any group offending this policy. You may be held liable for any damage to the building or furnishings; or non-return of the key. WECU provides this facility free of charge and expects that each group will treat the building and furnishings with care and respect.
