Your financial health matters to WECU.

With the annual inflation rate at a 40-year high, turbulence in the stock market, and a slowing of the economy, people are finding it harder to make ends meet. In fact, according to a recent Gallup Poll, sixty four percent of U.S. adults rate their financial health as "Fair" or worse, the most concerning figure since 2015.

Amidst this uncertainty, WECU is uniquely positioned to help our members live their best financial lives. I'm pleased to share examples:

EARLY PAYDAY

In May we introduced early payday. Early payday allows funds directly deposited into a WECU account to be available up to two days earlier.*

*Early access to automatic deposits depends on the day the money is sent. WECU deposits the funds on the business day the payment is received, which may be up to 2 days earlier than the scheduled payment date.

RAISING SAVINGS RATES

Throughout the second quarter, we made the decisions to increase interest rates paid to members for their savings certificates and savings accounts. We continue to lead the local market with the best rates, which rewards our members and provides them with a safe and secure place to put their savings.

FINANCIAL RELIEF

For members experiencing financial hardship, we provide relief in the form of loan payment deferrals and skipped payments for most consumer loans. We also provide debt counseling at no cost for our members through Money Management International. Our team also provides kind and flexible service that you won't find at most other financial institutions. We recognize, however, that while these types of measures can help in the short-term, they also need to be combined with long-term strategies.



FINANCIAL EDUCATION

Moving towards a place of financial health is often a matter of learning what steps to take along the way. On our website, we offer numerous financial education resources including blog articles, free webinars, podcasts, and videos. Additionally, we regularly host in-person and virtual financial education classes that our members, and those in the community, can attend for free. I encourage you to take advantage of all we have to offer on your financial wellness journey.

HERE FOR THE LONG TERM

Regardless of what happens in the economy, you can rest assured knowing that WECU is strong. We are positioned to withstand any future possible economic turbulence and will continue to invest in our membership and the community.
